

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR AMBULANCE SERVICE

1. If PROVIDER is an Indian Health Service facility, a Tribal facility, or an Urban Indian Clinic, the General Agreement and Special Provisions 2-4 below do not apply to PROVIDER. Addendum 1 to these Special Provisions applies to these providers.
2. PROVIDER holds a license as an ambulance service from the Oklahoma State Commissioner of Health through the Oklahoma State Department of Health or from the appropriate licensing agency in the state where the SoonerCare services are rendered pursuant to this Agreement.
3. Ambulance services are defined as in 63 Okla. Stat. § 1-2503(4) of the Oklahoma Emergency Response System Development Act, 63 Okla. Stat. § 1-2501-1-2516, or the appropriate licensure act in the state where services are rendered. PROVIDER agrees to abide by all restrictions on the provision of ambulance services as expressed by the Oklahoma Statutes and Oklahoma State Department of Health rules or the appropriate statutory and regulatory restrictions of the state where services are rendered.
4. Article IV Section 4.1 paragraphs (g) and (h) of the General Provider Agreement do not apply to PROVIDER.
5. The term of this Agreement expires on March 31, 2018.

**ADDENDUM TO
HOSPITAL OR OUTPATIENT FUNDING AGREEMENT
FOR THE PROVISION OF AMBULANCE SERVICES
SOONERCARE AMERICAN INDIAN/ALASKA NATIVE
TRIBAL HEALTH SERVICE PROVIDERS**

This Addendum applies only if the PROVIDER is a provider at an ITU (Indian Health Services facility, Tribal facility or Urban Indian clinic).

ARTICLE 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Addendum is to delineate Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) and PROVIDER'S agreement that PROVIDER will be reimbursed from OHCA for ambulance services.

ARTICLE II. HOSPITAL/CLINIC AGREEMENT

The parties have a current Funding Agreement for Hospital Services and/or Outpatient Clinic Services.

ARTICLE III. PROVIDER

3.1 PROVIDER holds all federally required licenses for ambulance service.

3.2 PROVIDER agrees to abide by all applicable restrictions on the provision of ambulance services as expressed by the federal statutes and federal regulations.

ARTICLE IV. REIMBURSEMENT (*Review this)

OHCA shall reimburse PROVIDER for ambulance services in accordance with the appropriate part of OHCA's Provider Manual § 317:30-5-336.5-et seq., Coverage by category and limitations.
