

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR LICENSED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL

1. Provider states that Provider holds a license, and applicable certification, from the appropriate licensure agency in Oklahoma or the appropriate licensure agency in the state where SoonerCare services are rendered. Pursuant to O.A.C. 317:30-5-240.3(a) the license and certification must be one of the following:
 - A. Allopathic or Osteopathic Physician with a current license and board certification in psychiatry or board eligible in the state in which services are provided, or a current resident in psychiatry practicing as described in O.A.C. 317:30-5-2;
 - B. Psychologist;
 - C. Social Worker (clinical specialty only);
 - D. Professional Counselor;
 - E. Marriage and Family Therapist;
 - F. Behavioral Practitioner;
 - G. Alcohol and Drug Counselor;
 - H. Advanced Practice Nurse (certified in a psychiatric mental health specialty), licensed as a Registered Nurse with a current certification of recognition from the board of nursing in the state in which services are provided; or
 - I. A Physician Assistant who is licensed in good standing in this state and has received specific training for and is experienced in performing mental health therapeutic, diagnostic, or counseling functions.
2. Provider agrees to abide by all restrictions as appropriate to Provider's license and/or certification as expressed by Oklahoma statutes and the applicable licensure board, or the appropriate statutory and regulatory restrictions of the state where services are rendered.
3. Services provided through telemedicine to improve access to health care services must comply with O.A.C. 317:30-3-27 and all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations.
4. The term of this Agreement shall expire February 28, 2024.
