SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR LICENSED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL

- 1. Provider states that Provider holds a license, and applicable certification, from the appropriate licensure agency in Oklahoma or the appropriate licensure agency in the state where SoonerCare services are rendered. Pursuant to O.A.C. 317:30-5-240.3(a) the license and certification must be one of the following:
 - A. Allopathic or Osteopathic Physician with a current license and board certification in psychiatry or board eligible in the state in which services are provided, or a current resident in psychiatry practicing as described in O.A.C. 317:30-5-2;
 - B. Psychologist;
 - C. Social Worker (clinical specialty only);
 - D. Professional Counselor;
 - E. Marriage and Family Therapist;
 - F. Behavioral Practitioner:
 - G. Alcohol and Drug Counselor;
 - H. Advanced Practice Nurse (certified in a psychiatric mental health specialty), licensed as a Registered Nurse with a current certification of recognition from the board of nursing in the state in which services are provided; or
 - I. A Physician Assistant who is licensed in good standing in this state and has received specific training for and is experienced in performing mental health therapeutic, diagnostic, or counseling functions.
- 2. Provider agrees to abide by all restrictions as appropriate to Provider's license and/or certification as expressed by Oklahoma statutes and the applicable licensure board, or the appropriate statutory and regulatory restrictions of the state where services are rendered.
- 3. Services provided through telemedicine to improve access to health care services must comply with O.A.C. 317:30-3-27 and all applicable federal and state statutes and regulations.
- 4. The term of this Agreement shall expire February 28, 2024.
