SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR OUTPATIENT SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER/CO-OCCURRING PROVIDER

- 1. Provider states it is an Outpatient Substance Use Disorder (SUD) provider.
- 2. Provider states that it is:
 - a. A provider performing substance use disorder and co-occurring disorder treatment within an outpatient setting; and
 - b. Currently certified by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services ("ODMHSAS") as an outpatient provider of substance use disorder and co-occurring disorder services in accordance with 450:18, unless exempt from state jurisdiction or an exempted entity as defined in 43A O.S. § 3-415.
- 3. Provider agrees:
 - a. To abide by all restrictions imposed by the accrediting body of which Provider holds accreditation, if applicable;
 - b. To meet the requirements of 42 C.F.R. Part 2;
 - c. To comply with outpatient behavioral health rules found at O.A.C. 317:30-5-240 through 317:30-5-249 *et seq*;
 - d. To assist any person treated at the facility to make application for payment on his or her behalf to OHCA for compensable healthcare services; and
 - e. To help its patients apply to enroll in SoonerCare, if so requested.
- 4. If Provider also provides other mental health or substance use disorder services outside of the scope of an outpatient substance use disorder/co-occurring provider, Provider agrees to execute a separate SoonerCare Provider Agreement for these services.
- 5. The term of this Agreement shall expire September 30, 2024.
